4. **JURY DEMANDS:**
Please appear via zoom at docket call to set the case and for status conference with the Court following the call of the docket.
5. You may continue to add cases after docket call on any of the provided dates by filing a Request to Docket in accordance with the Local Rules of the 12th Judicial District a minimum of 7 days in advance of the date requested.

PLEASE NOTE:
